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APPLICATION INFORMATION

Recommended Dosage	0.5% to 2.0% by weight of cement. Higher dosage may be used if agreed by engineer and consultant. Actual dosage to be finalised on the basis of site trials. Stir well before use.
Dispensing	Sikament®-108 X can be added into the mixing water or directly into the concrete mixer after 50% – 70% of the mixing water has been added. The addition of Sikament®-108 X to dry aggregate or cement is not recommended. To achieve optimum performance a minimum wet mixing time, which is depending on the mixing conditions and the mixer performance, of 60 seconds is recommended.
Compatibility	Sikament®-108 X may be combined with many other Sika® products. Compatible with all types of cements and cementitious materials. Important: Always conduct trials before combining products in specific mixes and combinations.
